TYPE OF LICENCE

This licence is a temporary limited licence and subject to the conditions specified in this licence authorises the licensee to supply:

- packaged liquor to residential and accommodation premises via home delivery;
- packaged liquor for takeaway from the premises.

LIMITATION ON AMOUNT OF LIQUOR TO BE SUPPLIED

The quantity of liquor supplied must not exceed more than two 750ml bottles of wine or one 750ml bottle of spirits or twelve containers (not more than 375ml per container) of beer, cider or pre-mixed spirits, or up to a combined 1000ml of spirits, sake and liqueurs, or a combination of one 750ml bottle of wine and either one bottle of spirits or six containers (not more than 375ml per container) of beer, cider or pre-mixed spirits.

DELIVERY CONDITIONS

The licensee must ensure that delivery arrangements include relevant provisions:

- regarding the prohibition on the supply of liquor to a person under the age of 18 years;
- requiring proof of age to be sighted where appropriate;
- that liquor is not delivered and left at unoccupied premises; and
- that liquor is not delivered to anyone who appears to be intoxicated.

PROHIBITION ON DELIVERY OF LIQUOR TO MINORS

Liquor must not be supplied or delivered to a person under the age of 18 years. The licensee must ensure that its delivery staff comply with the relevant provisions regarding the supply of liquor to minors.

TRANSFER OF LICENCE

This licence is not transferable.

PERIOD OF LICENCE

This licence has effect and continues in force until the earlier of:

- 15 September 2020; or
- The date on which the State of Emergency declared in Victoria over COVID-19 and announced by the Premier of Victoria on 16 March 2020 ceases to be in force.
